### Congratulations to Professor Roberto Martina on winning the prestigious 2023 FEO Excellence Award.

The award is awarded to somebody who has significantly contributed to the progress of Orthodontics in Europe. He presented his excellent lecture 'Orthodontic evolution, from Boomer to Zoomer' at FEO award ceremony in London to delegates.

Many thanks to Professor Roberto Martina for his support of Orthodontics in Europe over the past years.

Prof. Roberto Martina graduated with honors in Medicine and Surgery, a specialist in Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics and in Orthodontics.

He was Founder and Director of the School of Specialization in Orthodontics, President of the Degree Course in Dentistry and Director of the Department of Odontostomatological and Maxillofacial Sciences at the University of Naples "Federico II".

He was President of the Italian Society of Orthodontics (SIDO) for the two-year period 1990-1991 and President of the European Orthodontic Society (EOS) for the one-year period 2002-2003. He obtained certificates for the use of the Incognito TM and Win lingual techniques and the invisible aligners ARNIVOL and Invisalign. He obtained the Italian (IBO) and European (EBO) certificate of clinical excellence in Orthodontics.
